- ✓ The 20-bed central MICU (MICU-C) This unit provides acute, intensive care for medical & oncologic patients aged 14 years and older.
- ✓ The seven-bed MSICU-D sees medical and surgical patients aged 14 and older.
- ✓ The 7-bed MICU-E treats medical and oncology patients.
- ✓ The 19-bed Cardiac Surgical Intensive Care Unit (CSICU) provides care for adult and pediatric patients requiring intensive and acute care for the patient population requiring surgical treatment of cardiac problems.
- ✓ The 29-bed Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) provides care for patients admitted directly from Labor & Delivery and Newborn Nursery, or referred from an outside facility (the NICU at the King Faisal Hospital is the referral centre for premature infants born in the Kingdom).
- ✓ The 18-bed Pediatric Intensive Care Unit (PICU)) this unit provides acute, intensive care for medical, Surgical & oncologic patients aged less than 14 years.
- ✓ *Rapid response team(RRT)*

For all Inpatients, excluding Intensive care units, Recovery Room, & Newborn nursery. The Rapid Response Team is a formally designated multidisciplinary team that responds to the assessment and management of early signs of deterioration of patient's condition and does not require activation of the Code Team (Blue/Green) within the patient's areas specified in the scope.
