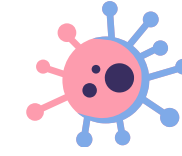
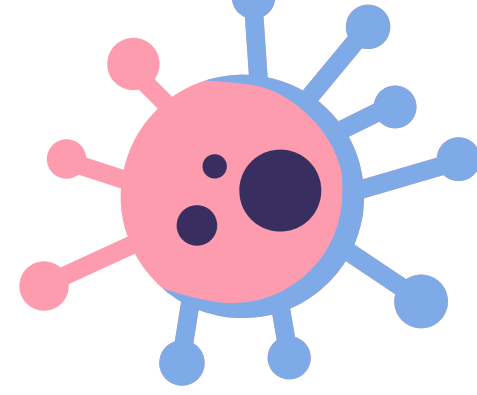

The Kingdom's National Programme to Achieve Liver Virus Removal by 2030. The main target groups for screening for viral hepatitis B and C are:

People who engage in harmful behaviors such as sharing contaminated needles or engaging in unsafe sex

Persons aged 35 or over

First-degree relatives with viral hepatitis B and C

Who has high liver enzymes

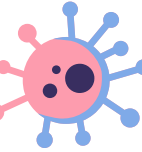
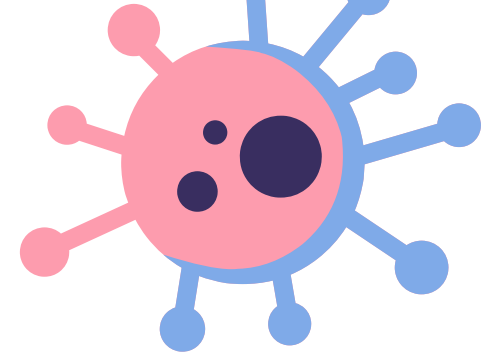
Frequent exposure to blood transfusion or a blood product or dialysis

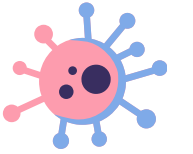
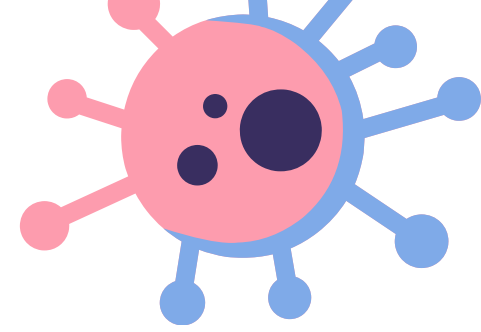


How to prevent transmission of hepatitis virus(B) From the infected pregnant woman to the newborn

- Appropriate treatment for pregnant women with the disease during pregnancy.
- After the birth of the newborn is given the first dose of the viral hepatitis B vaccine, and the antiviral serum in the first 12 hours of birth.
- Completing the child's doses of viral hepatitis B vaccine, according to the national vaccination schedule.



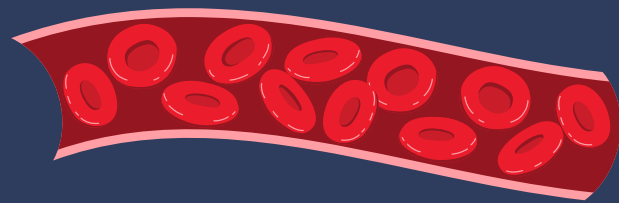

Types of viral hepatitis:

Hepatitis (C)

Transmitted through blood, often asymptomatic may lead to cirrhosis of the liver or liver cancer.



Hepatitis (B)

It is transmitted by blood or other bodily fluids. It can be acute or chronic, and in some cases, may lead to cirrhosis of the liver or liver cancer.



Hepatitis (A)

It is transmitted through contaminated food or water, often healed on its own without long-term medical intervention.
